EXPLANATION OF COURSES

HS446 HISTORY OF THE RESTORATION MOVEMENT

An examination of the (1800s) influence of B.W. Stone, and Thomas and Alexander Campbell on the American Restoration Movement, with focus on the concepts of prominent leaders within the movement.

BB314 HEBREWS

An expository study emphasizing the superiority of the priesthood of Christ, the finality of the cross as a sacrifice for sin in the New Covenant, and the confidence of the believer.

BB 102 NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY

An historical overview of the New Testament with primary emphasis on the unfolding plan of redemption. The survey will include a chronological examination of the birth and development of the church.

HS142 CHURCH HISTORY II

An examination of the church from the Reformation (1500's) to the present, with emphasis on spiritual revivals in various times and places.
