**NOTES**

1. Students attending KBC for the first time must submit an application and be accepted by the Executive Committee before registering for classes. A \$10.00 application fee must be sent with the application. (Previous SBS students are exempt, and do not need to do this.)
2. Pre-registration, registration, or late registration fees must accompany the registration form.
3. If financial aid is needed, complete the financial aid form and submit to the Executive Committee no later than three weeks after the beginning of the semester that aid is desired.
4. The registration fee and 20% of class fees must be paid at registration. The remaining fees, if any, must be paid by the end of the second month of the semester. If fees are not paid accordingly, the student forfeits the right of attending class(es). When classes begin, pay fees to Betty Ridgeway or Jerry Carmichael.
5. Students repeating a class will be charged one-half of the tuition.

## **EXPLANATION OF FALL 2017 COURSES**

**BB102 New Testament Survey** - An historical overview of the New Testament with primary emphasis on the unfolding plan of redemption. This survey includes a chronological examination of the birth and development of the church.

**BB306 Isaiah/Jeremiah** - An examination of the ethical implication of being GOD's people, then and now, HIS Holiness and judgement, HIS plan to send HIS Messiah and HIS Holy Spirit, and to establish HIS kingdom.

**CS118 Personal Evangelism** - An examination of the content of the gospel, man's required response, emphasizing evangelism through love, being sensitive to situations and needs of people, and new converts follow-up work.

**EP231 Principles of Christian Education** - This course surveys all aspects of Christian education with emphasis on effective teaching and learning processes.
